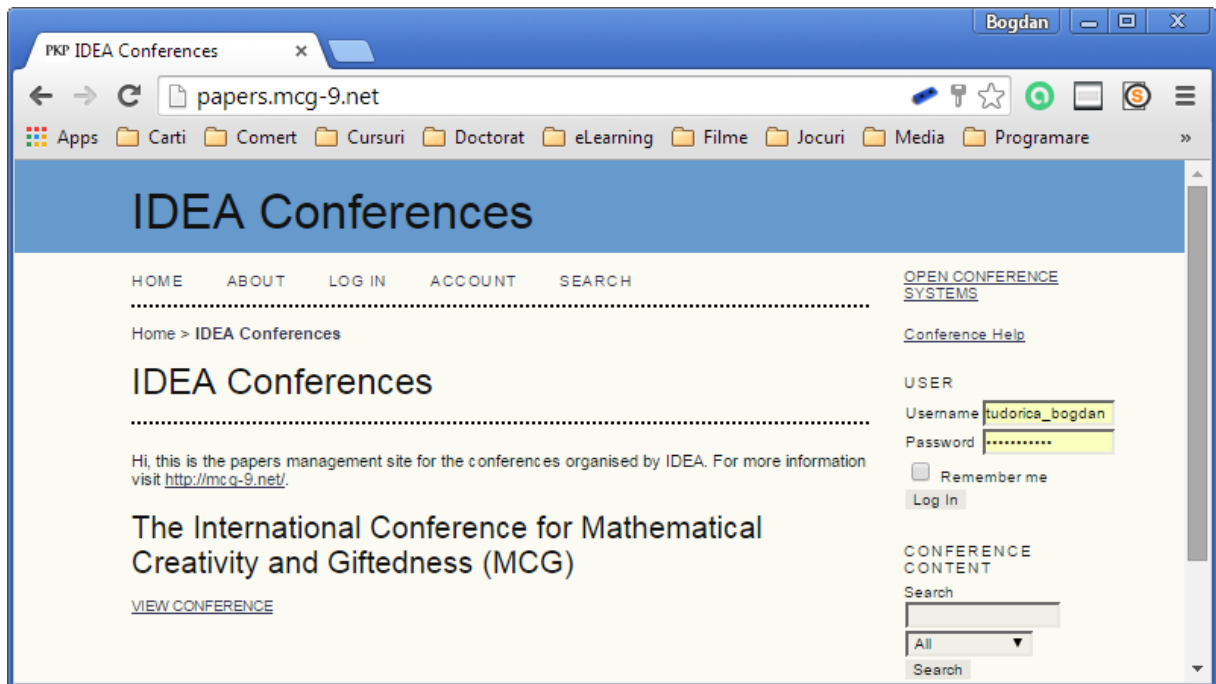
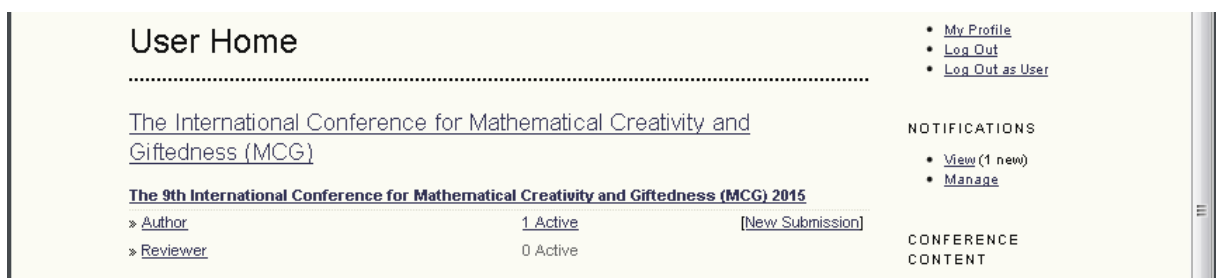


I wish to upload a revised version of a paper for the MCG-9 International Conference (I already created an account for myself, uploaded the original paper and the conference director requested that I should do some revisions on my work). How do I do that?

1. I open in any browser the following address: <http://papers.mcg-9.net/> (click on the address or copy-paste it in the browser address bar). A page like the following figure will open:



2. I enter my user name and password and then I click on **Log In**. My home page will open:



3. On this page I click on **1 Active** (1 is the number of papers I submitted to the conference. The actual number varies depending on the number of submissions). The list of submitted papers opens:
